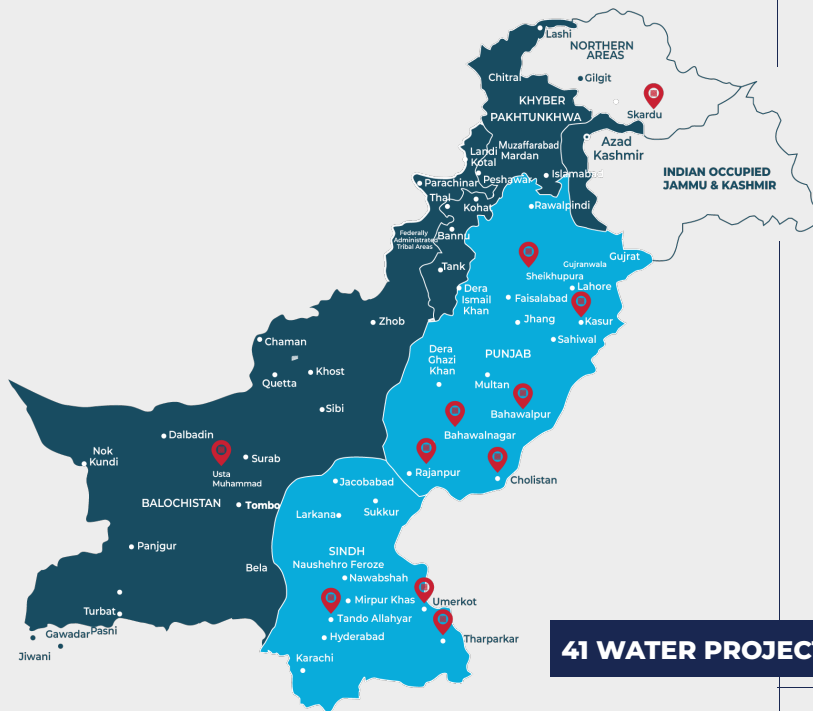

SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS, LASTING IMPACT

Our unique sustainability model champions a participatory approach. Communities take ownership, which ensures long-term operation of the plants for an uninterrupted supply of clean drinking water for generations to come.

In FY 24-25, we inaugurated nine new water filtration plants in areas including Tharparkar in Interior Sindh, Hasilpur in South Punjab, and Bhalwal in Sargodha.



CONSERVATION PROJECTS

Tamman: A small town community in Talagang, Punjab, was burdened by hefty electricity bills for their water supply. ZF facilitated the solarization of their water facility by providing an interest-free loan to the community.

Havelian: Our pilot deep bore project has been successful! This paves the way for cheap and easy water solutions for the masses. In just under **PKR 750,000**, more than **30** households in a village in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa can have access to clean drinking water.

CASE

HASILPUR, BAHAWALPUR

Zaman Foundation has installed **nine** water filtration plants in the area since 2021. As a result, access to clean drinking water has transformed daily life in and around Choonawala, Hasilpur.

Findings from the survey conducted by our Monitoring and Evaluation department show:

- ◆ Average reduction of **82%** in waterborne diseases*.
- ◆ Increase of up to **PKR 3,000** in monthly savings in transportation costs, boosting household resilience.
- ◆ Increased attendance in schools, promoting higher rates of literacy.
- ◆ Growing harmony and minimized conflict within the communities.
- ◆ Improved social relationships based on unity and mutual respect.

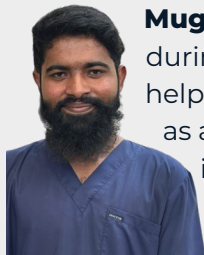

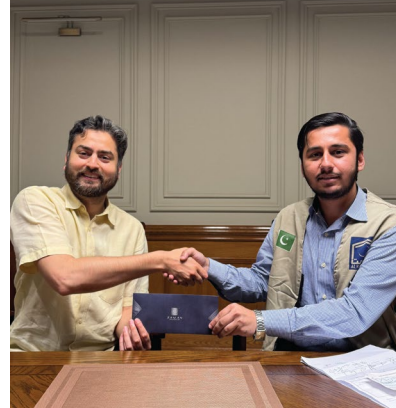

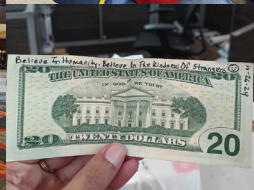
