# **FLOOD RELIEF**

Noor Muhammad returned home for his wedding to find his ancestral home destroyed and 24 of his family members washed away by flash floods. The tragedy struck the neighborhoods of Buner in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in August 2025, and swept away families, dreams and futures within minutes. 234 people lost their lives in Buner and hundreds more across the country have lost their homes and livelihoods as a result of unprecedented torrential flooding.

Team Zaman Foundation travelled to the major flood-hit cities to conduct in-depth needs assessment. We then distributed cash and/or relief packages based on the most pressing needs of our vetted families in the respective areas.



MULTAN: In partnership with Transparent Hands and Allied Bank, we set up free medical camps for flood affectees in Multan and Muzaffargarh. "24 of our family members were martyred in the flood including my father, one of my brothers and six brothers' families. We had a total of 34 rooms across three houses, that have been swept away. I am grateful to Zaman Foundation for the support and comfort they have provided us."

#### **OUR VETTING PROCESS**



#### 1. REGISTRATION

Our team visits the flood-affected families' homes, and records their personal information, e.g. their CNIC, as well as the extent of the loss incurred.



#### 2. VERIFICATION

When the applicant arrives at the venue, they are issued a token against their name in the list and requested to wait in line for their turn.



#### 3. AUTHENTICATION

The applicant's CNIC is double-checked against the list, and their signatures and thumb impressions are recorded.



#### 4. CASH/IN-KIND HANDOVER

Cash/Relief Package is handed over to the beneficiary with care and prayers.

Through our vigorous vetting process, we ensure the most efficient provision of support for the beneficiaries, and fool-proof transparency for our donors. # **CLEAN DRINKING WATER**

#### **DEEP WATER BORE**



**HAVELIAN:** The water tank accompanying our fourth water bore project in Abbottabad.

Each one of our projects is tailored to the most pressing needs of the community we set it up in, after thorough needs assessment. The successful pilot run of a deep water bore project in March 2025 paved the way for four more similar projects in Abbottabad. Here's how a deep water bore works:

- > A drilling rig is used to dig deep into the ground to bore water.
- Ground water is pumped out using a solar-powered submersible pump.
- > An accompanying water tank collects the groundwater.
- > 30+ households benefit from a sustainable source of clean water for years to come.

TDS, or Total Dissolved Solids is the number of dissolved particles in a body of water, including inorganic salts and organic matter. According to the World Health Organization, optimum TDS levels for drinking water should be below 300 ppm. In the previously deprived communities that we serve, TDS levels average around 1,000-7,000 ppm.

In Jhamrari Sharif, Tharparkar, TDS levels can rise up to 30,000 ppm! Our RO plant treated the contaminated water and brought the TDS levels within the WHO acceptable range - 250ppm, guaranteeing clean and safe drinking water for the community.
